



Call for the EGTC Duero-Douro town councils to implement a pilot project of e-geo-administration

The EGTC Duero-Douro is developing the **territoria.net** project, which is the definition of a **Management Information System** in Local governments in the border territory of Duero-Douro. This project has the financial support and collaboration of the **Fundación Biodiversidad**.

Given the changes that we currently face from in the municipalities, we had to provide a system that would modernize local government, making it more efficient and effective, while it enabled the provision of tools that enable each municipality manages integrally all competitions.

For this project, the EGTC will use a comprehensive e-geo-administration is GISLocal, which meets cartographic and administrative information of a municipality with telematic management software for each of the skills and activities of local entities.

The GISLocal is a comprehensive electronic e-geo-administration and therefore ensures local governance, municipal autonomy, rural development, sustainable management of resources and the natural heritage and providing quality services in real time and interactive citizens.

To make the implementation of the e-geo-administration and ensures continuity and efficiency, provides for the creation of a network of local agents of Custody and Territorial Administration responsible for developing, maintaining, updating and distribution network GISLocal and technical assistance local and social entities.

FUNCTIONS

The project focuses on the free implementation of GISLocal as pilot experience in local entities that request and includes:

1. The collection and organization of information mapping, cadastral and municipality administrative documents.
2. Installing the software Territorial Information System for Local Government (SITAL)
3. Training of technical staff
4. The configuration of the municipal electronic headquarters with the interactive telematic access of citizens.

All these actions will be absolutely free for EGTC Douro-Douro's member entities of, and will result in full implementation with all operations related before. To do municipalities interested in participating in this pilot shall on request at the earliest, undertaking the EGTC to implement in those municipalities that request before the end of the project.



Bearing in mind that the network of local agents of Custody and Local Government, composed by the trained technical staff for the development of services with these tools so they can serve their local City Council, but also to provide external services can lead an occupation for these people. This technical staff will be develop their work in member entities; therefore, interested Town Councils in this implementation will have to communicate at the same time to people that consider they have to be trained in order to develop their work in their village as Local Agents.

In addition, technicians will visit all municipalities of the EGTC interested in implementing the GISLocal, so these are appropriate to explain fully the content of this activity and the steps to be taken by municipalities.

For all these reasons, I encourage you, in case you consider it useful for your village and you are interested in implementing it, you can address to the EGTC Duero-Douro, so that you can arrange a visit to inform you in detail.

Also, ask you as widely spreading as possible all those people related to planning and local development that are interested in becoming a Local Agent of Custody of the Territory Duero-Douro, and they can attend also this Conference.

But for municipalities who wish it, they can apply, which shall include the following requests:

1. Identity of the applicant local authority
2. Municipal agreement and representative reference of the local authority in the project
3. Authorization to provide administrative documents of the Town Council and to access the information generated by other public administrations on the Town Council.
4. Proposed of township professionals interested in becoming Local Agent of Custody and Local Administration.
